



How to optimally use an automatic watch winder for my OMEGA watch?

To wind OMEGA watches automatically, we recommend a winder from our leather accessories collection. You can discover them at:

If you have a different winder, we indicate below the number of revolutions required per day, to ensure a minimum power reserve of at least 30 hours after removing the watch from the winder.

Please take note that we cannot guarantee the safe operation of equipment which has not been recommended by OMEGA.

The calibre (movement) of your watch is indicated by a pictogram on the pictogram card.

The below table indicates the number of rotations and winding direction recommended according to the calibre:
